



## Hackathon FAQs

1. **How are teams assigned?** You will be assigned to a team by RDK Management based on the topic and skills indicated on your registration.
2. **Can I request to be on a team with my colleague(s)?** Yes, you can include this request on your registration, but please ensure that your colleague(s) select the same topic.
3. **When will I be notified of my team assignment?** You will receive an immediate confirmation that you are registered. Approximately two weeks later, you will be notified of your teammates, mentor, RDK team lead, and other important details.
4. **How many people will be on each team?** The number of participants on each team will depend on how many registrants select each topic. If needed, topics will include into multiple teams.
5. **What training/mentoring is provided?** We will provide links to recorded webinars about topics relevant to all teams. After these general webinars, teams will have topic specific webinars, weekly team meetings, and communication via slack groups.
6. **When will training start?** General webinars will be available the week of October 5<sup>th</sup>, and then team specific training will begin.
7. **What is the weekly time commitment?** You can expect 2-3 hours per week of webinars and team meetings. Certain team subtasks may require additional time for independent development.
8. **What is expected of me during the Summit?** While the entire team is not necessary to present the final solution to the community, we encourage you to join for the entire daily sessions, Nov. 17-19th, 9:00 AM – 11:30 AM EST, so that you can hear the guest speakers, participate in the live Q&A, and view the other teams' solutions.
